*The DPHMP supports the Division of Professional Regulation in meeting three key goals:

1. Supporting both public and workplace safety
2. Helping licensees with substance use and mental health issues to recover and continue working safely
3. Helping keep experienced, trained professionals employed



* Who can take advantage of the DPHMP?

- * Any licensed professional regulated by a State of Delaware Title 23, Title 24, and Title 28 board or commission who is experiencing substance use and/or mental health issues



* Who is eligible?

- * Licensees must:
- * have an **ACTIVE** Delaware license or certification
- * **NOT** have committed an offense, other than the status of being chemically dependent or impaired, that would constitute grounds for discipline under applicable laws governing the profession



* Referrals: Self or 3rd Party

* The Board does NOT know

* The Attorney General's Office does NOT know

* Referrals: Board Ordered

* How?

- * As the result of a filed complaint and completed investigation forwarded to the Attorney General's Office
- * Consent Agreement with the Attorney General's Office, or
- * Hearing resulting in a Board's Disciplinary Order



- * Services provided that are included in the DPHMP:

- * Evaluation – determines treatment plan

- * Case Monitoring – supports compliance

- * Toxicology Testing – supports compliance

- * Website for licensees – program forms, guidelines, and payment status

- * Website for DPR – tracks compliance of enrolled licensees
